MANDATE LETTER - THE INTEGRATION OF FAITH AND LIFE: THE NEW LIFE OF CHRIST

The Catholic school facilitates learning to live this 'new life' by presenting Jesus Christ himself as the 'Model of genuine human development. Baptised and confirmed students need to learn how to integrate the powerful effects of these sacraments into their developing personalities. They need encouragement to develop all their personal gifts and to live as God calls them to live.

Today, the 17 March, we remember Saint Patrick, the patron of Ireland. Patrick was actually British. He was kidnapped as a teenager and bought to Ireland as a slave. Later he escaped, returned to his family and his studies and became a priest. Years later he returned to Ireland as a missionary and bishop. By the time Patrick died in 461, a great many Irish families had turned to Christ. Many Irish people came to Australia in the nineteenth century and helped the church to grow. The closing for today is part of a long poem he may have written.

GOSPEL Luke 10:1-12, 17-20

The Lord appointed seventy-two others and sent them out ahead of him, in pairs, to all the towns and places he himself was to visit. He said to them, 'The harvest is rich but the labourers are few, so ask the Lord of the harvest to send labourers to his harvest. Start off now, but remember, I am sending you out like lambs among wolves. Carry no purse, no haversack, no sandals. Salute no one on the road. Whatever house you go into, let your first words be, "Peace to this house!" And if a man of peace lives there, your peace will go and rest on him; if not, it will come back to you. Stay in the same house, taking what food and drink they have to offer, for the labourer deserves his wages; do not move from house to house. Whenever you go into a town where they make you welcome, eat what is set before you. Cure those in it who are sick, and say, "The kingdom of God is very near to you." But whenever you enter a town and they do not make you welcome, go out into its streets and say, "We wipe the very dust of your town that clings to our feet, and leave it with you. Yet be sure of this: the kingdom of God is very near." I tell you, on that day it will not go as hard with Sodom as with that town.'

The seventy-two came back rejoicing. 'Lord,' they said, 'even the devils submit to us when we use your name.' He said to them, 'I watched Satan fall like lightning from heaven. Yes, I have given you power to tread underfoot serpents and scorpions and the whole strength of the enemy; nothing shall every hurt you. Yet do not rejoice that the spirits submit to you; rejoice rather that your names are written in heaven.'
