# MANDATE LETTER - GOD IS EXPERIENCED TODAY IN WAYS REVEALED BY JESUS CHRIST

The Catholic understanding of these means is presented in the Catechism of the Catholic Church. To the extent that people enter into the basic experiences of the Kingdom proclaimed and made possible by Jesus, they find harmony between Go and themselves growing. Today's reading from the Sunday Gospel is a story Jesus tells about being awake and ready for God's call. He compares two groups of young women waiting for the bridegroom to arrive for a wedding. One group is well prepared, the other is not. He's teaching us to be ready for the wonderful day when we are called into God's kingdom. For those who are ready, that day will be as happy as a wedding.

## GOSPEL

Listen to the words of the Holy Gospel according to Matthew 25:1, 2-10

Jesus said, 'The kingdom of Heaven is like what happened one night when ten girls took their oil lamps and went to a wedding. Five of the girls were foolish and five were wise. The foolish ones took their lamps, but no extra oil. The ones who were wise took along extra oil for their lamps. The groom was late arriving, and the girls became drowsy and fell asleep. Then in the middle of the night someone shouted, 'Here's the groom! Come to meet him!'

"When the girls got up and started getting their lamps ready, the foolish ones said to the others, 'Let us have some of your oil! Our lamps are going out.' 'The girls who were wise answered, 'There's not enough oil for all of us! Go and buy some for yourselves.'

"While the foolish girls were on their way to get some oil, the groom arrived. The girls who were ready went into the wedding, and the doors were closed."
