Today we celebrated Ash Wednesday as a School Community. It was wonderful to see many parents and parishioners join us for this special Mass.

Ash Wednesday is one of the most popular and important holy days in the Liturgical Calendar. Ash Wednesday opens Lent, a season of fasting and prayer. Ash Wednesday takes place 46 days before Easter Sunday, and is chiefly observed by Catholics, although many other Christians observe it too.

Monday 2 March—Pupil Free Day (Public Holiday Labour Day) Ash Wednesday comes from the ancient Jewish tradition of penance and fasting. The practice includes the wearing of ashes on the head. The ashes symbolize the dust from which God made us. As the priest applies the ashes to a person's forehead, he speaks the words: "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return." Alternatively, as he did today, the priest may speak the words, "Repent and believe in the Gospel."

We wear our cross with honour and try to truly believe in the Gospel.

Thank you to all the parents who attended the Sacramental Enrolment night last week. If you were unable to attend, you may go to St Joseph's enrolment meeting on the 5th March at 3.30pm at All Hallows Church in Boulder.

A reminder to parents, children who are at school prior to 8.30am must come to the undercover area where there is supervision. They may not play on playgrounds or wait by the classroom door. I will inform children when it is 8.30 and they may go to classrooms.

The parking area in John St has certainly assisted us in relieving the congestion of parking at the end of the day. Cars are not to park in Shamrock St or on the verges surrounding the school.

Thank you to the parents who are supporting us in our endeavour to have all children wearing the correct uniform with pride. I have already noticed a marked increase in the number of children arriving to school with shirts tucked in and hair tied back correctly.

Our uniform focus for this fortnight is shoes and socks. Please encourage your children to come to school in polished shoes wearing the correct socks.

Today, Ash Wednesday, many Christians receive a cross of ashes on their foreheads. This powerful sign has been used by God's people for hundreds of years. It shows everybody that we are not perfect but are sorry and wish to be better.

We sometimes break the law of God. We hurt other people. We act selfishly. So today we tell God and each other that we are sorry. With the help of Jesus, we will try to become better during the forty days of Lent. The cross of ashes means all of these things.

For the next three days we read the Gospel story for the first Sunday of Lent. It tells us about the three tests Jesus had to face when he was fasting in the wilderness.

Listen to the Holy Gospel according to Matthew 4:1-4

The Holy Spirit led Jesus into the desert, so that the devil could test him. After Jesus went without eating for forty days and nights, he was very hungry. Then the devil came to him and said, "If you are God's Son, tell these stones to turn into bread."

'No one can live only on food. People need every word that God has spoken.'




