MANDATE LETTER - THE INTEGRATION OF FAITH AND LIFE: THE NEW LIFE OF CHRIST

The Gospel according to John 15: 1 - 8

Just as a branch cannot produce fruit unless it stays joined to the vine, you cannot produce fruit unless you stay joined to me. I am the vine, and you are the branches. If you stay joined to you, then you will produce lots of fruit. But you cannot do anything with me."




